## **Cohesive Paragraph Checklist**

 When appropriate, a title identifies the paragraph topic.
 The paragraph begins with a topic sentence that tells what the paragraph is going to be about.
 All ideas in the paragraph relate to the main topic.
 Ideas are presented in a logical order.
 Connecting words or transitions link ideas and signal how ideas are related to each other.
 Words and phrases relate to the topic and explain important ideas.
 Verb tenses are consistent.
 Pronouns are used correctly, and their antecedents are clear. (In other words, it is clear to what noun or pronoun each pronoun refers.)
 The style and tone of the paragraph are consistent and appropriate for the topic, audience, and purpose for writing.
 The conclusion relates directly to the topic sentence.
